Wayne County Transit (WCT) to End August 31

Here's what you need to know:

- Due to budget limitations, curb-to-curb WCT service operated by Stark Area Regional Transit Authority (SARTA) will end August 31.
- SARTA and Community Action of Wayne/Medina (CAW/M) will stop signing up new WCT customers immediately.
- SARTA will also discontinue contracted services with the Wayne County Board of Developmental Disabilities on August 31.
- Wooster City Transit will continue to provide fixed-route service for registered riders on the shuttle loop within the City of Wooster.
- Wooster Transportation Assistance Program (TAP) taxi trip passes are still available for eligible residents within Wooster City limits.
- The City of Wooster will establish a new combined city and county transit system as quickly as possible. This could take a year or more.
